### **Worship Notes**

In our prayers Don, Meaghan, Henry, Marie, Grace, Maureen, Bernice and John.

This morning's anthem was composed by "Stanley Dickson" which is a pseudonym for Australian early 20th century composer Mary Hannah (May) Brahe. Female composers in the early 20th century were not likely to get published and so the practice of taking a man's name to submit compositions was a key strategy. Successful in her native Australia, she was encouraged to go and pursue a career in music in London, England where she taught piano, accompanied and composed songs for leading singers of the day.

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#### Canticle of Hannah

- 1 Hannah prayed and she said, "My heart exults in the HOLY ONE OF OLD; my horn is lifted up in my God. My mouth [opens] wide against my enemies, for I will rejoice in my victory.
- 2 "There is none holy like the MOST HIGH, none besides you; there is no rock like our God.
- 3 Speak proudly no more, multiplying pride, nor let arrogance come from your mouth; for the AGELESS GOD is a God of knowledge, and by God deeds are accounted.
- 4 The bows of the mighty are broken, yet the feeble gird on warrior-strength.
- 5 Those who were full have hired themselves out for bread, yet those who were hungry are fat.
  She who was barren has birthed seven children, yet she who has many children languishes.
- 6 The CREATOR OF ALL kills and gives life; brings down to Sheol and raises up.
- 7 The GRACIOUS ONE makes poor and makes rich; brings low and also lifts up.
- 8 God raises the poor from the dust, and lifts the needy from heaps of human waste, to seat them with nobles and inherit a seat of honor. For to the CREATOR belong the pillars of the earth, and on them God has set the world.
- 9 God will guard the feet of the faithful who belong to God, while the wicked perish in shadow; for it is not by might that one prevails.

#### 10 The HOLY ONE OF SINA!

Those who strive against God shall be shattered; God thunders against them from heaven. The FOUNT OF JUSTICE will judge the ends of the earth; God will give strength to God's ruler, and exalt the power of the anointed of God."
